

THE SHERK FAMILY CEMETERY: HUMBERSTONE: lot 12, Con. 2.
N.S. of # 3 highway.

This very old cemetery stands back from the highway in the middle of a farmers field, just east of Sherk road, and some four hundred or so feet back from the Garrison.

When visited in Oct. of 1981, it was completely overgrown with sumach bushes and vines of every discription, so much so that the fence that surrounds it is almost unrecognizable. There was only one small stone in the upright position, readable; and about six other small markers of actual bolders.

On the ground there was six other stones that were readable.
