Nov. 1, 1937. Henry Harris released land to Stanley Joe known in Chinese as "Joe Dai Soy". His wife was Joe Wong Lun. His partner was Bock Jun.

Mr. Joe came to Canada in 1915 and moved to Fort Erie at the time he purchased this <sup>1937</sup> restaurant. He remained in business till 1965 just prior to his death on July 9th. The ext. of the estate granted the business to his wife Joe Wong Lun. On Feb. 28, 1967 she turned over the property to the nephew of Stanley Joe, Jung Y. Chew & his wife Shuck WanChew; or Jack Chew and Wendy Chew. They changed the name to "Happy Jack's".
