WILLIAM HENRY FORSYTH son of Nelson and Archange Forsyth born 2 March 1843
Nelson Forsyth was Justice of the Peace and Reeve of Fort Erie 1863-65 and 1875-77

WILLIAM HENRY FORSYTH died 27 March 1843

A Memorial To be Registered Pursuant to the Statute, of an
 indenture of bargain and sale dated the third day of September
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty
 four between William Beck, Esq. and Sarah his wife
 of the one part and William Bruce Esq. of the other part
 all of the Township of Burtis District of Niagara and
 Province of Canada Westmoreth. That the said William Bruce
 and Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
 One hundred Pounds of lawful money of said Province, to
 them in hand paid by the said William Bruce as a sign the
 receipt or return of the purchase money, the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, ceded,
 transferred, conveyed, and confirmed, and by their power do
 grant bargain, sell, give transfer, convey and confirm unto
 the said William Bruce his heirs and assigns Executors, all
 and singular tenements that certain parcel or tract of land and tenements
 - more particularly lying and being in the Township of Burtis
 in the District and Province aforesaid containing by a meas-
 -urement one acre, being comprised of the North West part
 of Lot number eleven, in the Township of Burtis, the concession of said
 Township of Burtis, and Burtis and Burtis or more, the
 aforesaid known as parcels of land is to sell beginning
 at the North West angle of said Lot number eleven in the
 Township of Burtis at the entrance for road between the
 Township of Burtis and the Township of Burtis, thence
 South West to the road between the Township of Burtis and
 the Township of Burtis, thence West to the line
 of the Township of Burtis, by a measurement one acre
 together with all the houses, out houses, woods and waters
 thereunto in any way and being, and all and singular the rights
 franchises and advantages to the said premises in any
 wise belonging, and the hereditaries, and Reversions, Remainders and
 Advowsons, Rents, Services and Profits thereof. Which said indenture
 is witnessed by Michael Palmer Esq. Esq. and John
 Thomas Esq. Esq. of the Township of Burtis and District
 of Burtis aforesaid, and is hereby registered to be registered
 by the grantee:

cast to the Mill Creek running through said lot
then following said creek in a North westerly direction
to above said creek intersect the line between the
number twenty four and twenty five then down to the
place of beginning a Spring and thence also through
said town to the said George Bunker and to the
line and adjacent to Dan the Miller of said mill town

for and to the line of mining & Mill or machinery
or to any other purpose for and to which the said
George Bunker may wish to apply the title of said

said John Bunker of us to or out of the above said
