This is a very large cemetery with both an old section and a new section, with several hundred burials.

Many of these family names are familiar to the Bertie area. The Edward Lee family lived on the old lakeshore road in Lowbanks. Edward Lee Sr. was the founder of Marshville(Wainfleet). For a time the Lee's lived in the Fort Erie area, and Edward married into the Hershey family that lived along the river road, not far from the Mac Afee Cemetery.

Several of the Buchner family settled in Lion;s Creek, and the Schooley's were an old family from the Ridgeway area of Bertie township.
