Dear Recipients, Family, Friends,

From time to time the Government of Canada recommends to Her Majesty that commemorative medals be struck to mark an important anniversary or a special occasion. Such medals were created for the centennial of Confederation in 1967, and for the 25th anniversary of Her Majesty's reign in 1977. This year, Her Majesty has approved the striking of a commemorative medal to mark the 125th anniversary of Confederation.

The medal is given to honour persons who have made a significant contribution to their fellow citizens, their community, or to Canada. Holders of the Victoria Cross, the George Cross, and the Cross of Valour, as well as the Companions, Officers and Members of the Order of Canada will also receive the medal directly from the Chancellery.

Community organizations took into consideration a number of criteria when reviewing possible recipients of the medal including: the selection of persons whose achievements or contributions are clearly appreciated by large segments of the population; ensuring that the list of candidates was representative of the regional population, therefore, composed of persons from various cultures, occupations, and fields of endeavour; ensuring that the persons nominated are exemplary citizens whose lifelong performance justifies the honour bestowed.

The recipients of this medal reflect the diverse nature of Canadian society and include persons from different professions, ethnic origins, and cultures. I am pleased, on behalf of the Governor General, to be able to present these well deserving citizens with this Queen's medal to honour their community achievements.
