made in duplicate the Fourteenth day of April  
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Twenty-Seven  
In Pursuance of the Short Forms of Conveyances Act:

Between

DAVID L. HERSHEY, of the Township of Bertie, in the County

of Welland, Farmer, hereinafter called the

"GRANTOR" of the FIRST PART, and

WILLIAM HEDLEY BENNER, DAVID L. HERSHEY, GEORGE E. SAUER,

ELMER ZIMMERMAN, and ROLAND SPEAR, of the Township of Bertie

in the County of Welland, Trustees duly appointed by author-  
ity and according to the forms of the religious society known  
as the United Brethren in Christ, hereinafter called the

"GRANTEES" of the SECOND PART, and

CATHARINE HERSHEY, wife of the Grantor of the First Part,

hereinafter called the

"PARTY" of the THIRD PART.

Witnesseth that in consideration of

DOES Grant unto the said grantee in fee simple

ALL and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and

being in the Township of Bertie, in the County of Welland, and being  
composed of Part of Lot No. 6, in the Third Concession from Lake  
Erie, in said Township of Bertie and being more particularly des-  
cribed as follows:

COMMENCING at the North-East Angle of said Lot  
No. 6; Thence Westerly 1 chain and 50 links; Thence Southerly 1  
chain and 67 links; Thence Easterly 1 chain and 50 links to Lot No. 5  
Thence Northerly 1 chain and 67 links to the place of beginning.

Excepting therefrom the lands conveyed by the said Grantees to  
the said David L. Hershey by Quit Claim Deed dated April 1st, 1927  
and registered April 14th, 1927, as No. 25625, for the said  
Township of Bertie.
