Capt. Christopher Buchner ::: died Sept. 7th. 1824 aged 59yrs.

Capt. C. Buchner was a Loyalist from Newtown N.J., whose family came from Holland or Germany to that place; and located the first farm recorded there. He married Sarah daughter of James and Eunice Forsyth, and purchased from his father-in-law, the property including the hill. He was a private in the 4th. Lincoln. In 1810 ensign, in the 2nd. Lincoln; and in 1812-14 with Capt. John Rowes camp and took charge at Chippewa after the Capt's. death. He had a son Lieut. John Buchner who died April 14th. 1828 at 31 yrs. He married Mary Ann Corbett (was mētaer was a Jeanson) . Their daughter married Donald Mc. Kenzie.

Mary Buchner wife died March 3rd 1854 75 Yrs.

He came into the province with the Buttlers Rangers in 1792

Peter served as a private under Capt. Henry Buchner's camp. of the 3rd. Lincoln.

Also in the same Comp. was Christopher Buchner, Henry Buchner Jr., and Joseph Buchner. Martin Buchner was a Capt. in Muirheads Comp. of the same Regt.

Lieut. John Buchner son of Christopher died Apr. 14th. 1828 34yrs.

Daniel Buchner was a brother to Christopher.

Henry Buchner came as a Loyalist in 1778 and lived till 1842 when he died at 82 yrs. His wife Joanna died in 1820 in her 55 yr. They are burried in Crowland.

JOHN FORSYTH ::: son of James & Eunice Forsyth of Niagara Falls
born Jan. 31st. 1781

John Forsyth removed to Batavia N.Y. and took up land from the
Holland Land Company; accompanied by his brother William, later
proprietor of the Pavillion Hotel in Niagara Falls Ont.

In 1810 John Forsyth married Miss Mary Ganson daughter of Capt.
John Ganson of Lennington Vt. They settled five miles from Batavia,
near Dunham Grove, remaining there till 1805.

In 1805 John Forsyth and his wife & child Edmund moved to land that
was later to take the name of Warren's corner. in N.Y. state. He
built a log cabin and later a tavern around 1808. After John's
death Mary married Ezra Warren in 1813 and thus the name of the
property became Warren's Corner.
