

HERSHEY FAMILY burying ground::: Centralia Rd. Bertie Township.

This small family burying ground is situated on the east side of Centralia Rd., which runs south off #3 not far from the corner of ridge rd., about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. In this plot there are only some twenty graves remaining, and these are situated by the road in the west end. About $\frac{1}{4}$ of the ground remains without any markers. For many years this was known as paupers field, for here were burried local people who could not pay for their plot or ground. There are no markers to these burials visable.
