THE. LAPP CEMETERY :: WILLOUGHBY .

THIS VERY SMALL FAMILY PLOT is on the north side of Detenbech rd.; which is now no more then a driveway off the Niagara Blvd. The stones are situated in a small plot of ground behind a guarage on this property, quite close to the river road. In 1974 there are about 13 graves recognizeable and in all there must have been slightly over twenty burriels. About six or so stones remain standing and most of the others are quite readable.

The plot seems to contain only three families : the Lapps the Saylor and the Hersheys.
