SPECIAL FISHERY LICENSE.

ISSUED UNDER THE *FISHERIES ACT*.

1880

The herein named *Ghos Ranney*

resident of *Port Erie* in consideration of payment to be made on the *delivery of this license* of the sum of *Sixty Dollars* is licensed during the year *1880*, as OCCUPANT, for the purpose of carrying on fisheries, of the FISHING STATION, situate and described as follows:

In Lake Erie, between Point Abino and Nares Point in the Township of Humberstone, County of Welland.

For the privilege of using two gill-nets with a single head or foot each

NOTE.—Nothing in this License will be held to prevent Angling or Trolling within the limits described; the same being accepted subject to such privilege.

The present License requires strict conformity with the various provisions of the FISHERY LAWS now (or hereafter) in force, and to all regulations emanating from the GOVERNOR GENERAL in COUNCIL and DIRECTIONS by FISHERY OFFICERS; in default of such compliance, the same will become void and forfeited forthwith, saving moreover the penalties imposed by law.
