The following are several pages from two school books used by members of the Lichtenberger family, in the "Little Red School House" on Bowen Rd. the lessons are in German and English for most of the settlers in the area could only speak the German language.

The first book was published 1873. It is signed as belonging to Katy Lichtenberger, and was given to her by her teacher George Endrulat.

Also used by John Lichtenberger. 1880's.

The second book was used by Fredrick Lichtenberger., when he was taught by Jane Gerrard -who served at Bowen Rd. :: 1889-1893. She lived in Buffalo at the time and used to walk over to the school each day to attend to her pupils.
