This Building at Waterloo and John St. was the home of a tile , and cement block business. In the late twenties and early thirties many of the homes in Fort Erie had work done by this father and son team. The house on Forsythe and Waterloo, south west side. A small cottage on the lower part of Bertie St, south side. Barns on the lower end of John St. used in 30's for a bread comp.
