4. At the end of the insurance year this book should be exchanged at a Local Office of the Ministry of Labour for a new book.
5. UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE STAMPS ONLY, of the appropriate value for men, must be affixed.

NOTES TO EMPLOYERS.

6. CANCEL THE STAMPS IMMEDIATELY AFTER AFFIXING THEM BY WRITING IN INK OR STAMPING BY MEANS OF A METALLIC DIE WITH BLACK INDELIBLE INK THE DATES UPON WHICH THEY ARE AFFIXED.
7. ON THE TERMINATION OF THE INSURED CONTRIBUTOR'S EMPLOYMENT RETURN TO HIM THE BOOK STAMPED UP TO DATE WHATEVER THE REASON FOR THE TERMINATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT.
