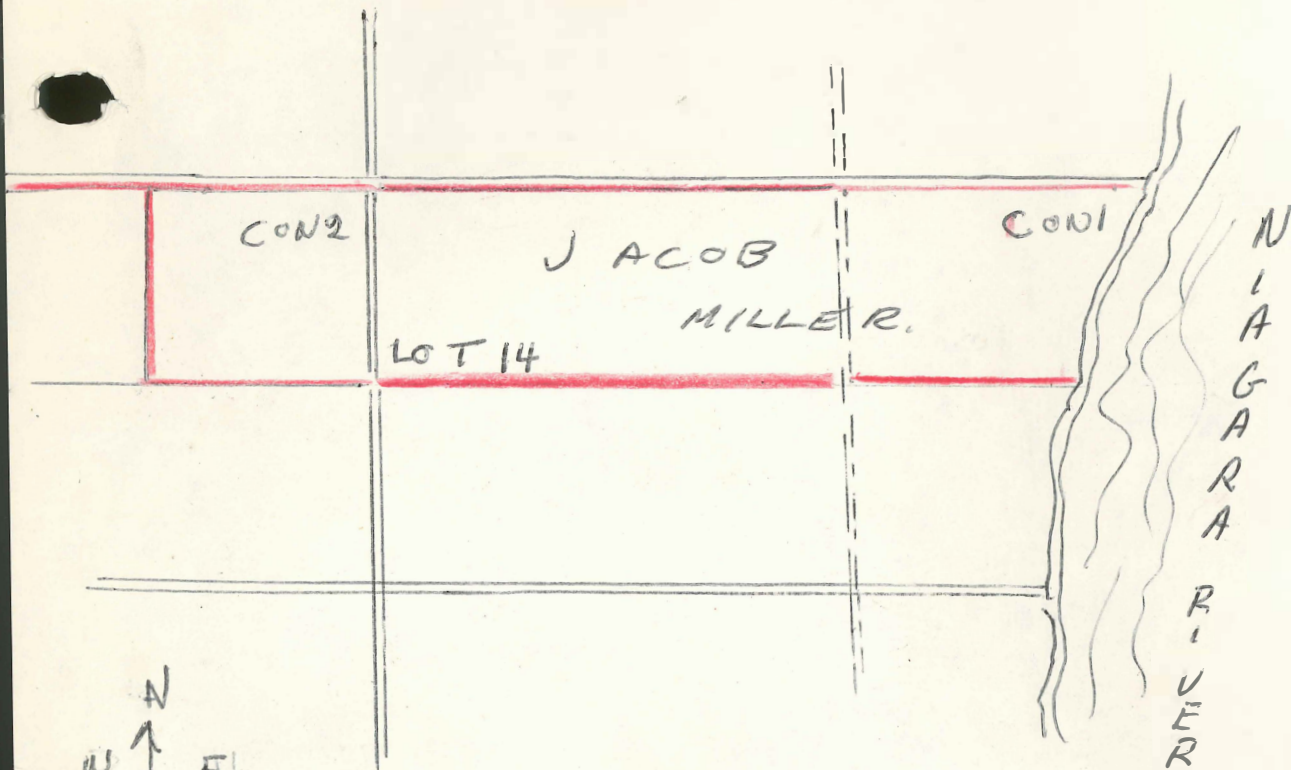

Solomon Miller lived in a log cabin when first occupying his homestead farm. Tired of the single life, he asked the minister of the Sauer to find him a wife. She arrived from Pelham.

however she refused to live continually in the log cabin. She insisted he build her a house. The actual date of construction, is thought to be in the early 1890's. Joseph Critz of New Germany who lived on the town line road just opposite the Hotel, decided to build an addition to his home and he built himself a Kiln nearby so that he could make his own brick. This he did in 1884, and tradition claims that the same stone was used in the Miller home. It was constructed by Mr. George Burger a bricklayer from Fort Erie.

## David Miller Home

This home, located on Ridge Road (formerly Ontario Road) near Montrose Road (W Crowland Townline) was built by David Miller before his marriage in 1875 to Christie Ann

They were married during the winter at Sauer's Evangelic Church (Willoughby United Church) and moved into their new home by an oxen team and sleigh.

Mrs. Martha Miller Morris is the only living child of the 5 children of David and Christie

Another David Miller lived in an original log cabin across from the location of this house on 100 acres of land, 100 on each side of the road.

The Miller family was very self-maintaining. Although the buildings are no longer standing, they had a tannery, a furniture factory, a sawmill and they made tombstones. A family cemetery still remains back to the 1700's.
