In the census of 1851 Peter and Elizabeth and children were living in a log house on 33 acres on part of Lot 2, Con. 11 Bertie Twp. Peter was listed as a labourer and a member of the Church of England. On a survey map of 1859, Elizabeth was a widow owning 15 acres of land. In 1874 she signed a quit claim to John N. ANGER for \$15 for 16½ acres in the south west corner of Lot 2, Con. 11. This could imply that the original 33 acres was not owned outright, but subject to ANGER family inheritance. (Registered Apr. 1, 1876 — #2692 Welland Land Registry)

By 1861 Elizabeth and her two daughters, Nancy and Sophia, were living with her parents, Philip and Elizabeth BENNER. Her widowed sister, Catharine CREGAR, had moved home with her children some years earlier. The parental roof sheltered them all in their time of need.
