1802::: Deeded to Benjamin Hardison by David Cowan.

Benjamin Hardison fought in Col. Phinnings Regt. of Mass troops during the American Revolution. He was taken prisoner at Quebec and held for two years. After the fighting he settled in Waterloo (Fort Erie) 1797.

He married Mary Jane Warren, the daughter of Col. John Warren. She was the first white child to be born at the Fort Erie post. The had eight children and to house them Benjamin built the large two story brick home at the foot of Queen St. facing the river. The walls of the old home were 15 inches thick, and the interior tr was black walnut, and the marbel fireplaces were transported from Italy in a sailing vesse.

In his will written in 1825, Benjamin leaves to his son David the homesteAD FARM, AND THE BRICK HOME WHICH IS CLEARLY STATED.

1858:::

The property including the home was purchased by William Wallace, thw builder of the Buffalo , Brantford and Goderich Railway, which had it's yards on the south side of Queen St. presently the site of the Legion Hall.

1880's By this time the old homestead had been converted into a Hotel with N.A. Dane as proprietor.
