CLAYTON**

William Earle Clayton, of 317 Albany Pl., Fort Erie, died at Douglas Memorial Hospital, Fort Erie, on Sunday, Feb. 7, 1988. He was 75.

Born in Montreal, Quebec, on March 26, 1912, Mr. Clayton was a purchasing agent for Canadair and lived in Shawbridge, Quebec, for many years before coming to Fort Erie six years ago.

A veteran of World War II, Mr. Clayton was a member of Branch 71 of the Royal Canadian Legion and Zone Commander for the Laurentian Command, Quebec.

Mr. Clayton was dear friend of Marion Parsons and uncle of Marguirte (Mrs. Vaughan Wilson) and Herbert (Muriel) Clayton. Also survived by several other nieces and nephews.
