

KRAFFT:::

STEVENSVILLE::: BOWEN ROAD. Lot # 8 con 10.

1855::: May 10th. John Troup sold to Francis Krafft west part of 8, :90 acres for £ 725.

1879::: Francis Krafft sold to George Krafft: 50 acres west $\frac{1}{2}$ of lot # 8 con. 10. £ 1500.

1890::: George Krafft sold to Charles B. Hill: 50 acres west $\frac{1}{2}$ of said lot £ 2000.

BERTIE::: Lot 3 con 1 L.E. Krafft Road.

1890::: Feb. 25. Charles B. Hill sold to George Krafft : sub. to mortgage \$ 5000.00.

1906::: Feb. George Krafft & his wife sell to Wm Krafft 11.7 acres : \$ 5000.00.

Bertie::: lot 5 con 1. by Dominion & Crescent rds.

1900::: Mortgage : Wm Krafft bachelor to Mary E. Rose.

1906::: Feb 7. Wm. Krafft & wife to George Krafft all of lot no 5 n. of the railway except part sold to Harry E Colburn : \$ 3500.00

1906::: Part of lot 5 north of G.F. to Wallie Peele.

1919::: July 2. Minerva A. Krafft, widow sold to Wm W. Gorham: 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres.

KRAFFT::: Stevensville;;;

1855: Francis Krafft purchased the farm on the S.E. cr. O Winger & Bowen Rds.

1879: George Krafft purchased the farm from his father. Ten of his eleven children were born here, except for John Henry who was born who was born in 1891, a year following their move from Stevensville.

KRAFFT. RD . no. 319.

George Krafft & family moved to this land in 1890. At the time it was the only house south of the Garrison on this rd. The farm was on the west side of the rd. south of the Dominion and just south of the railroad tracks. From here George and the family sold dairy products , milk eggs etc. the Americans who were building their summer homes along the lake.

DOMINION & CRESCENT:::no. 367.

In 1900 Wm. Kraft the eldest son held the mortgage on this property.

In 1906. Wm. Kraft sold to George Krafft.

In 1916 when her husband died Florence (krafft)Beach moved here from the U.S.A. with her children, to live with her widowed mother.

NIAGARA Blvd. In 1919 Minerva Kraft sold the Crescent R. home and moved to 709 Niagara Blvd. with Florence Beach & her children. Minerva Kraft died in 1933 and Florence Beach and her children continued to live here till 1938 when they moved back to the U.S.A.
