George Krafft & family moved to this land in 1890. At the time it was the only house south of the Garrison on this rd. The farm was on the west side of the rd. south of the Dominion and just south of the railrod tracks. From here George and the family sold dairy products , milk eggs etce. the Americans who were building their summer homes along the lake.

DOMINION & CRESCENT::no. 367.

In 1900 Wm. Kraft the eldest son held the mortgage on this property. In 1906. Wm. Kraft sold to George Krafft.

In 1916 when her husband died Florence (krafft) Beach moved here from the U.S.A. with her children, to live with her widowed mother.

NIAGARA Blvd. In 1919 Minerva Kraft sold the Crescent R. home and moved to 709 Niagara Blvd. with Florence Beach & her children. Minerva Kraft died in 1933 and Florence Beach and her children continued to live here till 1938 when they moved back to the U.S.A.

GEORGE KRAFFT::: STEVENSVILLE: the son of Francis & Catherine Krafft.
