Citizens of the U.S. do not require passports to enter Canada, but must have proof of citizenship such as a birth certificate.

Non-citizen residents of U.S. must have their resident alien card. Also, residents

of some countries do require special visas. Check with the nearest Canadian Consulate office.

GST REBATE

As a visitor to Canada, you are entitled to a refund of the Canadian Federal Goods & Services Tax you pay on a short term accommodation (less than 30 days) and most gifts/items over \$50 (before taxes). You can claim refunds up to \$500. Some restrictions apply. For more information call Peace Bridge Duty Free Shoppe Rebate Centre.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

Rates of exchange vary, as there are no laws enforcing the rate of exchange on foreign currency. Most local businesses will exchange your U.S. currency at their

going rate. Financial Institutions and Currency Exchanges will give you the current international rate of exchange.

DUTY FREE SHOPPING

Peace Bridge Duty Free has a wide range of products from alcohol and tobacco to perfume and jewelry.

U.S. Residents leaving Canada: Daily exemption \$200 (U.S.) per person, excluding tobacco & alcohol. Monthly exemption: After a 48 hr. stay, \$400 (U.S.) worth of goods including alcohol (1 litre) or beer (1 case) and 200 cigarettes or 100 non-Cuban cigars. Family members can combine their \$400 per person monthly import privileges.

Canadian Residents returning to Canada: After 24 hrs. Canadian residents

may import \$50 (Cdn) worth of goods excluding tobacco & alcohol; after 48 hrs. residents may import \$200 (Cdn) including alcohol (1 litre) or beer (1 case), 1 carton of cigarettes and 100 non-Cuban cigars and after 7 days; \$500 (Cdn) worth of goods including alcohol (1 litre) or beer (1 case), 1 carton of cigarettes and 100 non-Cuban cigars.

ONTARIO LIQUOR LAWS

Fort Erie's liquor and beer stores are open daily except Sundays. The legal drinking age is 19.

POSTAGE INFORMATION

Postage for letter or postcard up to 30 grams is \$0.45 within Canada, \$0.52 to U.S. and to overseas countries \$0.90 for up to 20 grams.

Museums preserve Fort Erie's past

The Fort Erie Railroad Museum carries young and old alike on a sentimental journey.

Visitors can climb into the cab of CN Locomotive No. 6218 and sit where engineers once commanded the mighty 4-8-4 Northern. A companion caboose is also open for visitors to stroll through and marvel at the rough comforts of this compact "mobile home".

You can tour the Ridgeway Station, C. 1910 and find tools, photographs, telegraph equipment and personal memorabilia. Serene in the present, it was once a whirlwind of tears and hugs, steam and whistles, children's fantasies and real adventures.

The 1873 B-1 Station houses a reference library and sits in the well kept grounds of the museum, perfect for family picnics. The site is located on Central Avenue near Gilmore Road, open daily May 20 to Labour Day, 9 am to 5 pm. Open weekends from Labour Day to Thanksgiving.

Designated as a historic site, the Fort Erie Historical Museum is located

in an 1874 former Town Hall. With such details as tin ceilings, soft lights, and oak wainscoting, the story of Fort Erie is told. From the ingenuity and struggle of the Neutral Indians to the traditions and crafts of the United Empire Loyalists, Greater Fort Erie encompassed 36 villages and hamlets; some prospering in past centuries, many retaining their unique charm today.

Hands-on exhibits encourage visitor interaction. Located at 402 Ridge Road, the museum is open daily, from mid-June to Labour Day, 9 am to 5 pm. Open throughout the rest of the year for research purposes by appointment; call (905) 894-5322.

The quaint cabin of the Ridgeway Battlefield Museum was built in the early 1800's and inhabited by John Teal's family when the Fenians (Irish Americans) invaded in 1866. The home stood on the edge of the famous Battle of Ridgeway in which 18 soldiers lost their lives.

The Fenians were seasoned Civil War Soldiers attempting to "liberate" Upper Canada in a bid to negotiate Ireland's

freedom from Britain. Although the unsuccessful invasion lasted a mere three days, the Fenian Raids convinced statesmen of the day that Britain could not be relied upon for the country's defense. Confederation followed one year later. The Battlefield Museum is located on Hwy. No. 3, east of Ridge Road, open daily from mid-June to Labour Day, 12:30 pm to 5:00 pm.

Fort Erie's three civic museums have a unique three-for-one admission pass: \$2 for adults and \$1 for children gets you into all three of the museums. All three can accommodate bus groups and school tours. Please call (905) 894-5322 for details.

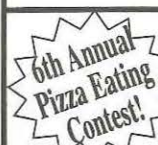

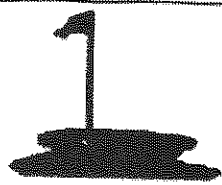
"Paradise" is a word you hear quite often when speaking to a windsurfing enthusiast in Fort Erie. You'll even hear words like awesome, electric and powerful too!

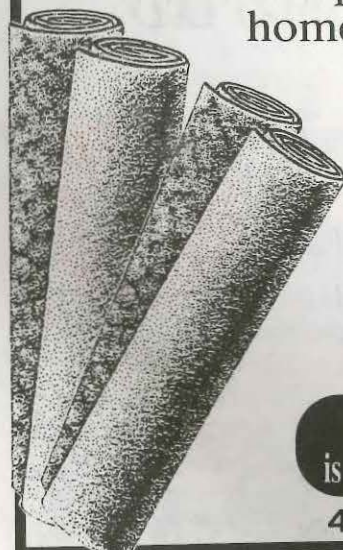
The Niagara River Recreation Trail
