1870's

Mr. W. Anderson father of Mrs. Shaw and Mary Mannering was the first postmaster in Amigari, in the store Building of William Magwood. This building stood on Gilmore Rd., just up from the Grand Trunk Hotel and what later became the corner of Dunlop Street. A Mr. Moore took over the position after Anderson and then it past to Mr. Hurrel, who also ran store from this building. In later years building burned, and the store was moved into the barn, and taken over by Mr. Malkin.
