

HURONS: Early in the 17 century the Hurons or "Wyondots" numbered 16.000 souls; They lived in a narrow district between Lake Erie & Georgian Bay of Lake Huron. There were four tribes: the Bear: Rock Dear & Cord.

The Algonkins lived around the Ojibwa.

The Petuns to the southwest across a wide stretch of unpopulated forest were the TIONONTATES called Petuns or Tobacco Nation.

The Ojibwa numbered 20.000 lived on the northern shores of Lake Huron & Superior from Georgian Bay to the praries. Their name ment people whose moccasins have punched seems.
