1795. The lands in Bertie: lot 1 & 2 in the 2nd. con. & lots 1.& 2 in the third con with B.F/ were owned by the Palmer family: marked J.P. Palmer on early maps. John & Joseph Palmer the sons of Sergeant Palmer were recommended 200 acres each: all 492 acres.
1801. Crown to Joseph Palmer:
1802. B.&.S. John Palmer etux, eldest son of Joseph Palmer to John Mc. Kay 492 acres: all lands.
- Jan. 2, 1833. Lewis Palmer etux to Henry Putman: 100 acres:  
lot # 1 con.2 L.E. ( this is no doubt range 3.)
- Sept. 1836. Henry Putman to John Thorn: 2 acres, pt. of lot #1 con 3. commencing at a post at the distance of 3 acres from the Garrison Rd. and running north east in rear of said road; 2 acres: thence Swesterly 1 acre to a post: thence west 2 acres : then 1 acre
- Sept. 22. 1836. Henry Putman to Elizabeth Thorn 6 acres of lot 1 con. 3 L.E.: commencing at N.E. Cr. of said lot, fronting on the Garrison Rd. running north easterly along the Garrison rd. 2 acres thence S. Westerly 3 acres to a post: thence west 2 acres: thence north 3 acres: to the place of the beginning. ( This appears to be the north east cr. later sold to E. Finch.)
- July 1840. Henry Putman to John Quick 100 acres(lot 1 con.3L.E.) except land sold to John Thorn 2 acres and the N.E.cr. sold to Elizabeth Thorn ( his dght) 6 acres.
