DR. William Borget of Buffalo built this large three story frame home on the Niagara Blvd. facing the Pump House, as a summer residence in 1898.

It had several outbuildings, and to the north side of the home was a tall windmil, which pumped water into a large holding tank that stood in the attic.

In this home the Borgets spent their summers with their four boys Leo: Herbert: Albert: and Cyril. Around the year 1924 after the death of Mrs. Borget, the remainder of the family moved permantly, to their home in Fort Erie.

IN 1936 Mr. Borget passed away after a short illness and his son Cyril continued to live in the old home. He later married Lenora Willick and after their marriage she moved from Stevensville to this residence. After the death of her husband Lenora, continued to live at this address until Jan 1981, when she moved into the Albany Place Apartments just a short distance away.
