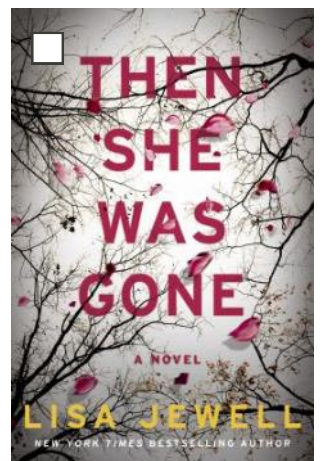
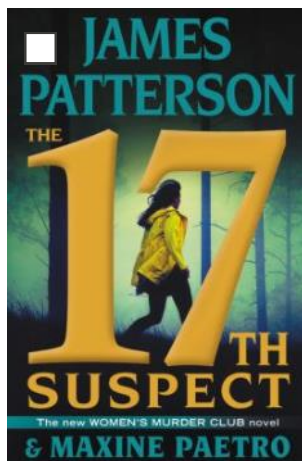
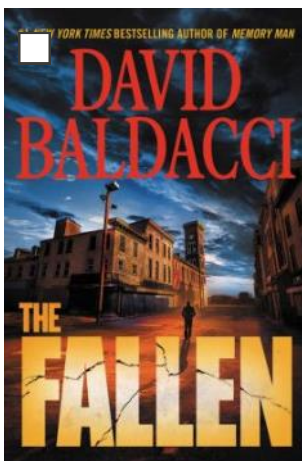
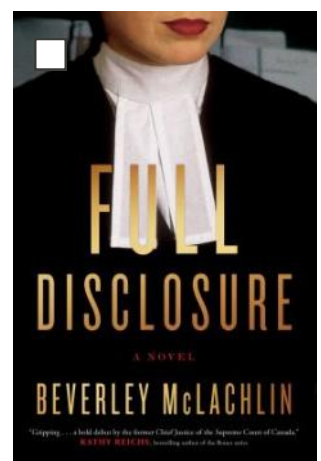
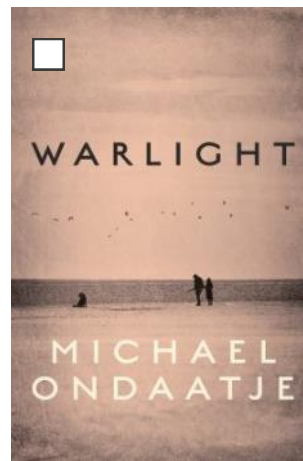
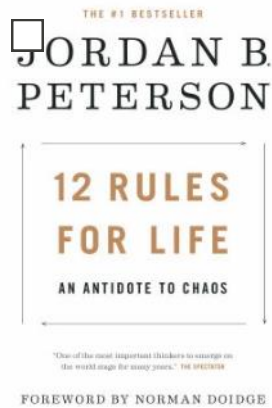
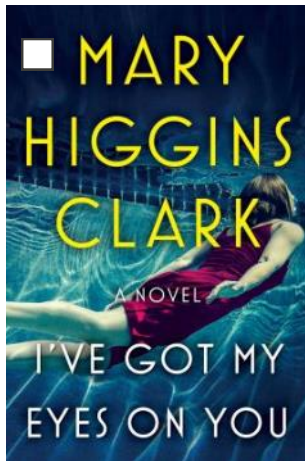


The Home for Unwanted Girls
