

Entire Audience Joins In At Barbershoppers Event

FORT ERIE — When "Fort Erie's Al Jolson" wants to sing a solo and when a sell-out crowd applauds wildly and croons alcag with enthusiasm, one would have to conclude Saturday's "Parade of Harmony" will be a terrific addition to the border town's roster of annual events.

The local chapter of the Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barber Shop Quartet Singing in America put this one on. If it does not become an annual event, all sorts of people will be disappointed.

It was unusual to see Fort Erieans, noted by some for their

conservatism, walk into the auditorium of Fort Erie Secondary School and several hours later walk out singing or smilling.

Starting off the show was the Peace Bridge Area Barbershop Chorus, which warmed things up with "Coney Island Babe" and softened the mood with the tear-jerker, "Just a Song at Twilight".

Cheers, not mere applause, greeted a local quartet, the Frontiersmen, for its rendition of "When You Were Sweet Sixteen". Comic relief was provided by a Buffalo, N.Y., group, the Nifty-Tones and local fans

In fact at one point in the production, Mayor John Teal, who brought greetings from the municipality, expressed his disappointment at not being allowed to deliver a solo.

A few years ago, he won fame in now defunct minstrel shows as "Fort Erie's Al Jolson": striding down local ramps in black face. However, he did say that, "If each and every one of us sings more of the songs that are in our hearts, there would be fewer tears tomorrow".

LADY QUARTETS

Described as the "greatest border incident ever", the show featured lady barbershoppers, the first anywhere, from both sides of the international boundary. The Lake Erie Dearies and the Buffalo-Fort Erie Sweet Adeline Chorus upstaged their husbands with such tunes as "Yes Sir, that's my Baby" and "In the Good Old Summertime".

Master of Ceremonies George Shields, of Toronto, conducted a sing song and after the first few bars he could well have taken a front seat. Not only did the gallery respond, but it actually exulted in harmony.

Probably at no time have as many residents made public their desire to sing. Among them were, in addition to Mayor Teal, former choir boys, bathtub baritones, and sinus sopranos.

PRESENT CHARTER

This was a charter night for the local chapter and Ontario president Sam Grey presented a sheepskin to border president Bill Taylor for continued membership.

Mr. Taylor, by the way, was probably the most frustrated soloist of the evening. In a truly funny skit, he was upstaged by star tenor Paul Pudwell every time he opened his mouth for a magnificent "Sweet A-do-line".

It was mentioned during the evening the "Parade of Harmony" might well become an annual affair. The second "border incident" most present realized, will have to be staged in a much larger hall, to accomodate the horde it is sure to attract.



CODE OF ETHICS

- (10) We shall render all possible altruistic service through the medium of barbershop harmony.
