"The Argyle Boarding House."

Christine Edwards (Jackson) ran this very popular boarding house on the north side of Jarvis St. It was quite the fashionable place with about eleven regular borders and at time as many as forty to sixty sitting down for the supper meal. Among the guests were, Mr. Cornell, Doctor Chapman, to Cliver., Mr. Terrell

The original building was put up for DR. Menke, when he came to Fort Erie. It was later sold to Frank Benner. It was rented for a time by Dr. Hammond, and stood empty for some time before it was baught by Christine Edwards.
