Mrs. Barnea was born in Devonshire England, coming to Canada at the age of twelve. She lived at Woodstock for a number of years , having one son Harry.

After the death of her husband she married Nicholas Alonzo Barnea and lived in Welland for some time. They came to Fort Erie, and for a number of years operated the Old Victoria Hotel on Courtwright St. They left this business and opened the Barnea just east on Courtwright St.

When Mr. Barnea died Martha went to live with her son Harry in Welland who was running the Welland Hotel there. She eventually moved back to Ridgeway where she lived with Harry's son Percy Rice, in a red brick house on the cr. of Hazel St. and the Ridge.

The Barnea::: built at the time of the railway bridge in the 1870's: It served to house the construction workers, and also the men that came to town to work on the railway. It has been in continuous use ever since.
