OLD CEMETERIES OF WILLOUGHBY TOWNSHIP Z.M. Miller 1963

- 1. TOM MCCREDIE & DELL CEMETERY (See Churchs).
- 2. Large R.C. Cemetery at Snyder. Also one on the Sodom Road opposite the United Church in Snyder, which was opened in 1845.
- 3. The WEAVER Cemetery on the Weaver Road west of the Sodom Road.
- 4. The Old Gonder Cemetery on the old Gonder farm, which is now owned by the Mayor of Fort Erie, Mr. Teal (1963). Most of the stones here are broken.
- 5. The old Miller family cemetery on the Ives farm, where there are about 20 graves and most of the stones are broken.
- 5. The Hersey Family Cemetery on the hill on the north side of the Miller Road. My Grandfather, Jacob Miller, gave this road in 1851.
- 7. The Lapp Cemetery on the Detenbeck Road which side road was given to the Township by the early pioneer Isaac Lapp.
- 8. Graves in fence corners on the Charles Wale and Albert Weaver farms.
- * There were three early families of Millers who settled in Bertie and Willoughby Twps. The Andrew Miller of Miller's Creek, my ancestor b.(1766-1843) graves were moved from under a tree on the property and placed in Andrew Miller Jr. b.(1799-1862) plot at St. John's Anglican Church Cemetery, Ridgemount. Our branch's graves are here including the Laurie and Ryson Audrey Miller Laurie. Z.M. Miller's grandfather was Jacob Miller.
