Dod became manager of the Bank in Dunville.

Mrs. Margaret (Hershey) lee was the grandmother of Warren Lee of # 12 Emerick Ave. Fort Erie.

The Emerick's came to Bridgeburg when the town was just being laid out. Jarvis had laid out from Courtwright to Phipp what had been known as Victoria, the land north of that was almost all farmland. Mr. Emerick built a large frame home on the river Road at the corner of the ST. that was to take his name::: Emerick. He owned a great deal of the land west of this home, and the site for ST. mary as church Hall was aquired from him.

Mr. Emerick was postmaster of the Town of Bridgeburg for many years.
